SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION

Selection Criteria and Application Instructions:

- A scholarship may be awarded to an ASIS member and full or part-time students who are enrolled in an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university, and have completed at least one year of study in a Public or Private Security, Criminal Justice, Legal Studies, or Pre-Law program, at the time of application, and seek a security or law enforcement career.
- Only those applicants, who include *all* of the required documents listed below in their application packet at the time of application, will be considered for a scholarship award.
- Student's academic enrollment and grade achievement attained only during the calendar year beginning January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015, will be considered.
- Applicant financial need will *not* be a consideration for awarding scholarships.
- Our local chapter's Scholarship Selection Committee will review all submitted applications and required supporting documents, in selecting each scholarship winner. Multiple \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded. (One local chapter scholarship recipient **may** be selected for the ASIS Foundation, Inc. matching award). The *ASIS Foundation, Inc. reserves the sole right to make the final determination as to who may receive a matching award. ASIS members* may be eligible for **up to a \$1,000.00 match and non-members up to a \$500.00 match.**

Applicants will submit the following required documents:

1. A completed "Applicant Information" form.
2. A copy of your official school transcript, including your cumulative grade-point average if applicable.
3. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member or colleague.
4. A 250-word narrative that describes your plan for a career in the security profession, including degrees and/or professional development courses, applicable memberships, and specific areas of interest.

Application Due Date:

- Completed application packets **must be submitted by mail, and received no later than Friday, October 2nd, 2015.**

Scholarship Awards:

- Scholarships will be awarded during our chapter's annual "ASIS Law Enforcement and Public Safety Appreciation Luncheon," to be held on Thursday, December 3rd, 2015, at 12:00 noon, at Salvatore's Italian Gardens, 6461 Transit Road, Depew, New York.
