- Completed application packets must be received **no later than Wednesday, November 25th, 2020.**

**SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION**

**Selection Criteria and Application Instructions:**

- A scholarship may be awarded to full or part-time students who are enrolled in an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university, and have completed at least one year of study in a Public or Private Security, Criminal Justice, Legal Studies, or Pre-Law program, at the time of application, and seek a security or law enforcement career.
- Only those applicants, who include *all* of the required documents listed below in their application packet at the time of application, will be considered for a scholarship award.
- Student's academic enrollment and grade achievement attained only during the calendar year beginning January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, will be considered.
- Applicant financial need will *not* be a consideration for awarding scholarships.
- Our local chapter's Scholarship Selection Committee will review all submitted applications and required supporting documents, in selecting each scholarship winner. Multiple \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded.

**Applicants will submit the following required documents:**

1. A completed "Applicant Information" form.
2. A copy of your official school transcript, including your cumulative grade-point average if applicable.
3. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member or colleague.
4. A 250-word narrative that describes your plan for a career in the security profession, including degrees and/or professional development courses, applicable memberships, and specific areas of interest.

**Application Due Date:**

- Completed application packets **must be submitted by mail, and received no later than Wednesday, November 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020.**
