Every time we turn on the news, there is a mass shooting in a supermarket, in our backyard, in a school full of children, or at a popular tourist destination. Nobody is safe from mass shootings these days; can we prepare ourselves? Retired Police Chief Kristen Ziman will speak about her experience with a mass shooting in Aurora, Illinois when she was the Police Chief.

The shooting occurred after an employee had been terminated and returned with a gun. Five people were killed and multiple people wounded. Survivors commented that there were several warning signs shown by the shooter prior to the incident and that the event could have been avoided if those signs were addressed.

Having a culture that allows for people to come forward and report these signs and offer support will help each of us do our part in identifying warning signs and eliminating future occurrences of mass shootings.

Come and learn how to empower yourself and your coworkers. You can override the feeling of helplessness and fear by empowering people with knowledge and action steps. This talk is all about empowering people to act so you don't find yourself in a horrific tragedy as Chief Ziman did.
